

## WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Clean and Gone is fully committed to achieving the highest standard of safety performance, by creating and maintaining a safe work place for all personnel associated with the business' activities.

Clean and Gone's goal is to protect the health and safety of its workers so far as reasonably practicable, by the provision and maintenance of working environments under our management and control in a condition that is safe and without risks to physical and mental health and to ensure workers are equipped with ongoing knowledge and training to perform their work within these environments in a safe manner.

Clean and Gone is committed to:

- Providing and maintaining a safe and healthy working environment for our employees, contractors and visitors for the prevention of work-related injury and ill health;
- Establishing measurable objectives and targets to ensure continued improvement aimed at elimination of work-related injury and illness.
- Developing, implementing, maintaining and adhering to procedures, processes and planning that establish safe and healthy environments;
- Ensuring that all our practices, processes and procedures comply with relevant work health and safety legislation, regulations, codes of practice, and guidelines and ISO 45001.
- Identifying hazards, assessing risks and implementing and maintaining effective risk management control strategies;
- Regular review and evaluation of health and safety systems including audits and work inspections;
- Eliminate hazards and reduce OH&S risks
- Ongoing consultation and participation of workers at all applicable levels and functions in the development, planning, implementation, performance evaluation and actions for improvement of OH&S Management system.

The Director of Clean and Gone will take responsible precautions and exercise due diligence to comply with safety obligations.
